- A. CALL TO ORDER. At 1:02 p.m., Chairman Ellis called the meeting to order.
- B. ROLL CALL OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS., Chairman Ellis, Directors, Stafford, Albaugh, and Gallagher were present. Director Moore were absent.
- C. AGENDA APPROVAL, ADDITIONS AND/OR DELETIONS. Director Gallagher motioned to approve the agenda as written. Director Albaugh seconded. Motion was approved 4-0.
- \mathbf{D} . CLOSED SESSION – No closed session item(s).
 - PUBLIC COMMENT. E.

Damon Shea of C&S provided update, including the improvisations they used while dealing with the storms, staffing challenges, and the changes occurring during the transition phase. He also reported that they had a truck in the parade.

F. REPORTS AND INFORMATION

- 1. Unagendized Reports by Board Members. No reports.
- 2. Auditor's Report. Received by Board. Several questions were asked and answered.
- 3. Claims of Expenses. Received by Board. Several questions were asked and answered.
- 4. Staff Reports. Mr. Heimbigner reported that the Bass Hill Landfill is closed to the public due to staffing issues, but is open to C & S. He said the Eagle Scouts have a cleanup project needing dump services and discussion was held suggesting that the Scouts present at the Board of Supervisors to get a waiver.

Mr. Heimbigner provided an update on SB 1383, and that staff is working on a resolution to ask for an exemption to be presented at the next meeting. He stated that CalRecycle has offered to come answer questions, and he is hoping to have them meet with both the LRSWMA Directors and the Board of Supervisors.

G. CONSENT CALENDAR

Subject: Approval of and/or Additions to and Deletions from the May 21, 2021; October 26, 2021; and November 23, 2021, Board of Directors Regular Meeting Minutes. Director Gallagher motioned to approve the agenda as written. Director Albaugh seconded. Motion was approved 4-0.

H. REGULAR SESSION

1. Subject: That the Board receive update regarding privatization of all solid waste operations. Mr. Heimbigner stated that after the Ad Hoc meeting, edits have been made and the agreement is back with Counsel. It will then go to C & S Waste for their review.

Discussion was held to clarify Waste Connections DBA C & S Waste Solutions, and also projected timeframe for agreement completion and negotiations.

2. Subject: Consider entering into agreement with R3 Consulting Group, Inc. to provide technical services to authority staff in privatization Negotiations. The Not To Exceed amount requested in \$25,000.00. Mr. Heimbigner elaborated on what services will be provided.

Mr. Albaugh expressed concern over lack of accountability per verbiage of agreement. Mr. Heimbigner said that services would be on an as needed basis only, with LRSWMA being in control of the agreement.

By vote, motion was unanimously passed to enter into agreement with R3 Consulting Group, Inc. to provide services to authority staff in privatization negotiations, with a Not To Exceed amount of \$25,000.00.

A RESOLUTION OF THE LASSEN REGIONAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY OPTING TO AFFIRM AN EXEMPTION FROM THE REQUIRMENTS OF MANDATORY ORGANIC COLLECTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, Lassen Regional Solid Waste Management Authority is committed to meeting its solid waste diversion requirements through program implementation of its Source Reduction and Recycling Element of its Integrated Waste Management Plan; and,

WHEREAS, Lassen Regional Solid Waste Management Authority is committed to meeting its mandatory commercial recycling requirements, pursuant to PRC, Section 42649.3, through program implementation as clarified in the Model Mandatory Commercial Recycling Program for Rural Counties; and.

WHEREAS, Senate Bill (SB) 1383 (Lara, 2016) was signed into law and establishes methane emissions reduction goals of 50 percent in the level of the statewide landfill disposal of organic waste from the 2014 level by 2020 and 75 percent by 2025 and increase edible food recovery by 20 percent by 2025; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) developed regulations in Title 14 Natural Resources, Division 7, Chapter 12: Short-lived Climate Pollutants in the California Code of Regulations to implement the goals in SB 1383; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 12 Article 3 (commencing with Section 18984) Organic Waste Collection Services requires jurisdictions implement an organic waste diversion program that provides organic waste collection services to all businesses and residences; and

WHEREAS, Section 18984.12 (c) allows a rural jurisdiction to adopt a resolution exempting the jurisdiction from the requirements of Article 3 based upon findings as to the purpose of and need for the exemption; and,

WHEREAS, Section 42649.8 of the Public Resources Code defines a rural county as a county that has a total population of less than 70,000 persons; and

WHEREAS, there are 19 counties in California with populations of less than 70,000 persons, which collectively represent only 2.0% of the statewide waste stream; and,

WHEREAS, organic waste generators within rural jurisdictions that meet the definition of "Rural Jurisdiction" in Section 42649.8 of the Public Resources Code that are exempted pursuant to paragraph (1) of subdivision (c) of Section 18984.12 are not required to comply with the organic waste collection requirements specified in Article 3; and,

WHEREAS, Lassen Regional Solid Waste Management Authority encompasses the County of Lassen, which has a population of 27,572 persons, which is less than 70,000 persons, as of the California Department of Finance's most current population estimate; and,

WHEREAS, Lassen Regional Solid Waste Management Authority does not have the existing infrastructure, composting or anaerobic facilities, with the capacity to economically handle all the organic waste produced within the county; and,

WHEREAS, with the amounts of organic waste generated in the jurisdiction of Lassen Regional Solid Waste Management Authority, it is not currently economically feasible to build sustainable processing facilities necessary to handle all the organic waste produced within the jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, with the amounts of organic waste generated in the jurisdiction of Lassen Regional Solid Waste Management Authority and the distance to accessible processing facilities, it is not economically feasible for Lassen Regional Solid Waste Management Authority to require organics diversion at this time; and,

WHEREAS, Lassen Regional Solid Waste Management Authority is committed to continue to pursue economically feasible alternatives for organics management; and,

WHEREAS, Lassen Regional Solid Waste Management Authority is committed to encourage businesses and residences to reduce and recycle organics materials; and,

WHEREAS, on December 31, 2026, this exemption shall become inoperative, unless subsequent legislation or department regulations or approvals extends the rural exemptions beyond that date, at which time portions of the county may qualify for the low population waiver (census tracts with less than 75 people per square mile).

Now, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lassen Regional Solid Waste Management Authority hereby chooses to exempt the juridiction from the requirements of Article 3 of Title 14, Division 7, Chapter 12 of the California Code of Regulations (commencing with Section 18984) Organic Waste Collection Services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Directors reserves the right to rescind this resolution at any time prior to the sunset date of December 31, 2026.

SUBJECT: That the Board consider changing the Bass Hill Gate Keeper position

from a 0.6 FTE to a 1.0 FTE.

DATE: February 22, 2022

Due to changes in available personnel it is recommended that the Bass Hill Gate Keeper position be re-programmed from a 0.6 FTE to a 1.0 FTE. The Bass Hill Gate House actually requires 1.2 FTE to fully staff due to Bass Hill Landfill being open for 6 days per week (Monday – Saturday. Other part time gate keeper staff will be utilized to cover the extra 0.2 FTE needed to staff the Bass Hill Gate House.

The budget for staffing already includes the necessary funding to staff the Bass Hill Gate House 6 days per week.
